The Board reviewed the key elements of the Provincial Framework Agreement between the Government of Alberta Ministry of Education and the Alberta Teachers' Association (ATA). This agreement includes 0% in wage increases over the next three years, a 2.0% increase in the fourth year, a 0.34% increase in 2014 to adjust the Horizon ATA salary to the provincial average and a lump sum payment of 1.0% in November 2015. Other components of the agreement deal with instructional time limits to be addressed through Ministerial Order, teacher workload, professional development, lieu days for principals, local bargaining enhancements, as well as a comfort letter from the Ministry to the ATA.

Moved by Bruce Francis that the Board support the adoption of the proposed four year Provincial Framework Agreement negotiated between the Government of Alberta Education Ministry and the Alberta Teachers' Association.
